

# Rocking R's RV Ranch

## Park Rules and Regulations

### Pet Policy

- Any time pets are outside your RV, they must be on leash held by the owner or in dog run and must be supervised at all times.
- All pets must have proof of rabies vaccination.
- **Owners must clean up after their pets!**
- Long-term/monthly RVers may erect personal dog run on their site at approval of management.
- Dogs that dig and destroy property and aggressive dogs are not allowed.
- Limit 2 pets per site.
- Management has the right to refuse any animal from being brought into the park and will ask you to remove any pet that causes a disturbance.
- No pets are allowed inside bath house/washaterias.

### Pond and Pavilion

- Pond decks are first come first serve and cannot be reserved. Do not leave personal items, fishing gear, trash, etc. at decks or in pond areas.
- Fishing at the pond is catch and release unless otherwise specified by management.
- Please return outdoor games to storage when not in use.
- Pavilion may be reserved/rented in advance for special occasions. See management to make arrangements and for approval. Otherwise feel free to gather there with other guests to visit and play board games, cards, dominoes, etc. Please keep voices and noise to a minimum.
- Leave all these common areas as you found them.

### General Info and Rules

- No cigarette butts or trash of any kind on the ground.
- Smoking is only allowed at your campsite and in the common areas around the pond and pavilion. Smoking is not allowed in the bath house/washaterias or office/store. Snuff out and properly dispose of cigarette butts. Do not snuff out butts on decks or tables. Empty any ashtrays in trash when leaving the common area. Be sure all butts are completely out so as not to start a fire.
- Personal items cannot be stored outside your RV. Patio furniture and outdoor cooking grills are only allowed.

- Do not leave any trash or any personal items behind at your site when you check out.
- Speed limit in the park is 8 mph.
- Golf carts and side-by-side ATVs are allowed but only on paved/gravel areas and must be driven by a licensed driver.
- Quiet time is 10:00 pm till 8:00 am.
- Alcoholic beverages are permitted in the park if used responsibly. Rowdy, violent, destructive behavior will not be tolerated. Guests will be escorted off property immediately!
- Do not place feminine products, paper towels, wipes or anything other than septic safe toilet paper in RV or public toilets.
- All sewer hoses must have a sealed connection to our septic system.
- We reserve the right to refuse service to anyone except those prohibited by law, and the right to remove any guest not following the rules set forth herein. Any unused site credit will be forfeited. We are very friendly, run a very friendly park and hope we never have to do this.
- Rocking R's RV Ranch will make every reasonable effort to provide a clean and safe environment for our guests. However, we disclaim any responsibility for damages resulting from fire, theft, accident, vandalism, or natural disaster. In case of emergency, call 911 and then notify management.
- As a courtesy, our host or one of the owners may assist with directing you to your designated RV site. It is your sole responsibility to ensure that the site will accommodate your specific RV and vehicles on the campsite. Rocking R's RV Ranch will not be held liable for any damage caused to your vehicle, RV or our facility in the process of parking/positioning your RV on the site.
- Our guests agree to keep their RV's and vehicles fully insured, road legal and in good operating condition. We want our guests to feel safe and secure if and when an emergency occurs.
- Speed limit within the park is 10 mph. Be sure to drive and park on rock or concrete only, make wide turns, and do not cut corners, the ground can be very soft.

## Camping Etiquette

- Basic common sense rules! We expect everyone to be friendly, courteous, and respectful to your fellow camper.
- Do not walk across another camper's site.
- Obey the park's quiet hours from 10:00 pm – 8:00 am. Keep in mind that voices, music and other noises carry farther than you might think outdoors.
- Clean up after yourself in the common areas and bath house/washaterias. Help us keep our park and facilities clean for everyone to enjoy.
- Loud, argumentative and foul language will not be tolerated!
